Project Mosaic was created in memory of New York Firefighter Lieutenant David J Fontana, who gave his life while rescuing people at the World Trade Center in New York City following the attacks of September 11, 2001. David Fontana was one of 343 firefighters that died while helping to rescue some 28,000 people from the North Tower and the South Tower of the World Trade Center.

- Teaching tools for schools to promote multicultural good citizenship and combat group hatred
- Global Citizen Champions Programme, with inspiring “global citizens” giving talks at schools
- Citizenship courses for immigrants and their descendents
